"Cheetah Spots" Poster

Put the spots back on the cheetah.

This is a simple, fun activity for learning, coloring or raising money for cheetahs. Lots of ways to put the spots back on the cheetah: color a spot for every cheetah fact you know, every 15 minutes of reading or use as a fundraising tool for supporters who donate money. Donation = 1 spot to color. Have fun with it!

Supplies:

- Enlarge and print black & white cheetah picture (download 8.5" x 11" image on website). If you want to make it larger, please re-size & print.
- Piece of poster board, cardboard or use an empty cereal box side
- Markers or colored pencils
- Paste printed cheetah picture to stiff surface (poster board, cardboard, etc.)

How to:

1. Using markers or colored pencils start coloring the spots on the "Cheetah Spots" poster.

Ideas for putting the spots back on the cheetah:

Color in a spot for every cheetah fact you know.

Color in a spot for every 15 minutes of reading.

Color in a spot for every cheetah fact your family and friends know.

Cheetah Kids has used this as a fundraising tool for supporters who donated a \$1 and then got to color a spot on the cheetah. Set a \$ amount goal and go for it!

Have fun putting the spots back on the cheetah & remember to share what you learned with family and friends!
